A Parks, Recreation and Beautification Board Meeting will be held on Tuesday, June 12, 2018, 6:00 p.m. at the Newcastle Storm Shelter, 851 N. Carr Drive, Newcastle, Oklahoma. This Hearing will allow interested citizens to ask questions and comment on the City of Newcastle's Oklahoma State Parks 2018 Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant Application regarding the Splashpad Project at Veteran's Park.
